Lieutenant Colonel Gerald R. Dull joined the Pittsburgh District as the Deputy Commander on July 28, 2014. As the Deputy Commander, he manages the District's mission within the Ohio River Basin, which includes 328 miles of navigable waterways on the Allegheny, Monongahela, and upper Ohio Rivers. Pittsburgh District's 26,000 square miles include portions of western Pennsylvania, northern West Virginia, eastern Ohio, western Maryland, and southwestern New York. The District's infrastructure includes 23 navigation locks and dams, 16 multi-purpose flood damage reduction reservoirs, 80 local flood reduction projects and other projects to protect and enhance water resources. With 148 years of experience, the Pittsburgh District has developed expertise to accomplish its varied Civil Works missions in the areas of navigation, flood damage reduction, recreation, water supply, environmental restoration, hydropower, storm damage reduction, regulatory, and emergency response.

Lieutenant Colonel Dull came to Pittsburgh following a three year assignment in Kaiserslautern, Germany, where his most recent assignment was as the G3 Chief of Operations for the 21st Theater Sustainment Command. His previous assignments include Division Engineer and Chief of Protection at Fort Riley, Kansas and COB Basrah, Iraq; Secretary of the General Staff, U.S. Army Alaska at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska; U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Alaska District, Project Engineer at Fort Richardson, Alaska; U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Gulf Region North District, MNSTC-I Program Manager, COB Speicher, Iraq; Executive and Operations Officer, Special Troops Battalion, Fort Richardson, Alaska; Engineer Observer/Controller, Combat Maneuver Training Center, Hohenfels, Germany; Company Commander of Charlie Company, 299th Engineer Battalion, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, Texas; Engineer Brigade S-3 Operations Officer, 4th Infantry Division, Fort Hood, Texas; Platoon Leader in the 23rd Engineer Company (Combat)(Heavy), 6th Engineer Battalion at Fort Richardson, Alaska. A resident of Wyoming, he was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant from the United States Military Academy in 1992.

Lieutenant Colonel Dull is a licensed Professional Engineer in the state of Missouri. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Environmental Engineering and a Master of Science in Engineering Management from the Missouri University of Science and Technology. He is also a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and the Engineer Officer Career and Basic Course.
