DUTIES: Position may be filled at mid or full performance level. Works as a member of an electrical repair team, performing maintenance on mechanically operated systems (electric, hydraulic, pneumatic, or combination thereof). Performs the full range of diagnostic major maintenance inspections, new installation, major maintenance and/or major overhaul on all lock and dam operating systems, machinery, electrical components and related equipment at navigational locks and flood control reservoirs characterized by electrically and/or hydraulically operated gates and valves. Performs major maintenance, rehabilitation and new installation of highly complex electrical systems and equipment. Is subject to call at any time to travel to any location in the District to locate and correct malfunctioning equipment which at times may render the facility inoperative. Inspects, troubleshoots, and/or disassembles the electrical components of the associated equipment at the structure, repair station or floating plant (such as generators, pumps, compressors, etc). Performs other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS: Your Résumé should demonstrate that you possess sufficient knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the duties of this position without more than normal supervision. Your resume will be reviewed for the following skills: Knowledge of equipment assembly, installation, repair, etc.; Technical practices (theoretical, precise, artistic); Ability to interpret instructions, specifications, etc. (includes blueprint reading); Ability to use and maintain tools and equipment; Knowledge of materials and troubleshooting. US Citizenship is required. **Note: Applicants must provide proof of State, National, or Local certification or license that a Master or Journeyman electrician may hold.**
