**DUTIES:** Position may be filled at mid or full performance level. Manufactures parts and items of equipment from different metals and other materials and performs machining work in manufacture of casting, forgings, weldments and other fabrications. In addition, performs assignments which usually require special adaptation or extension of the use of conventional machine tools and numerically controlled machine tools. Plans and lays out work, sets up and operates machine tools, and performs bench and assembly work. Operates machine tools such as lathes, vertical and horizontal boring mills, bench, plain or universal milling machines, shapers, planers, internal and external grinders, radial drills and numerical-controlled machine tools. Performs other duties as assigned
