- Diagnose problems in a variety of mechanical, electrical, hydraulic and plumbing equipment/systems and determine corrective measures.
- Operate heavy equipment.
- Read and interpret blueprints, sketches and other materials necessary for construction, maintenance, or repair of facilities.

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#### QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

Candidate must also demonstrate the following knowledge, skills, and abilities: knowledge of engineering equipment assembly; installation, repair, and modification of mechanical systems, plumbing systems, carpentry work, electrical work, etc.; technical practices; ability to read and interpret instructions, specifications, blueprints, building plans, etc.; measurement and layout; ability to use and maintain tools and equipment; and knowledge of materials associated with the work to be performed.

**PHYSICAL EFFORT:** Makes repairs on equipment or in installations often on high or hard to reach places, working on steep or uneven ground, steep stairways, ladders or platforms. The work requires walking, standing, stooping, bending, kneeling, and climbing, and may be performed in cramped positions, under equipment, in structures and on uneven surfaces. If selected, you will be expected to frequently lift and carry parts and items weighing over 50 pounds, pushing heavy loads, and operating heavy hand-held equipment.

**WORKING CONDITIONS:** Incumbent works in a variety of conditions. Work is completed on but not limited to scaffolding, high ladders or rooftops subject to dangers such as but not limited to falling, exposed to possibility of burns, cuts and bruises, broken bones or infections.
