Sand and Gravel Dredging Ohio River Mile 44.0 to 44.3

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that Tri-State River Products, Inc. will be dredging for raw material, which will be processed at the land- based plant into construction aggregates, on the Ohio River from River Mile 44.0 to 44.3 in Hancock County, West Virginia.
2. The work will be performed 11 hours a day, 5 days a week beginning May 2, 2013 and ending around January 2014.
3. Work will be performed from a 50' by 150' crane barge with a mounted Komatsu PC-1800 excavator. Also utilized will be two transfer deck barges, 52' by 195'. During non-working hours the equipment will be relocated to within 150' of either the right or left descending bank when dredging within 1000' of the Newell Bridge.
4. Mariners should monitor radio frequency channels 6 and 10 while transiting in the vicinity of the work site. Please contact either M/V Timothy James or dredge platform Big Tom for precise location information.
5. Navigators, please use caution in and around the area.
