Overhead Transmission Line Replacement Monongahela River, River Mile 96.9

- 1. To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that Mon Power Company a subsidiary of FirstEnergy Corporation will be replacing a 138 kV transmission line crossing the Monongahela River at river mile 96.9, downstream of the Morgantown Lock & Dam in Star City, Monongalia County, West Virginia. (Latitude 39.67187, Longitude -79.97938)
2. The power line replacement will consist of an aerial replacement with the use of helicopters. There will be no work within the Monongahela River resulting in no delay or impact to navigation. Upon observation of an approaching vessel, the work will temporarily halt to let vessels pass through the work area. The work will begin and be completed on June 18, 2013. Work hours will be from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
3. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
4. Radio marine channels will not be monitored during the construction.
