Restricted Use of Upper and Lower Guide Walls

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that due to infrastructure conditions and safety concerns, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will no longer be able to assist deck hands with placement of tow lines on the upper and lower guide walls. **Until further notice, the upper and lower guide walls at Lock 2 and CW Bill Young locks are OFF LIMITS to all personnel.**

2. All vessels requesting passage through Lock 2 and CW Bill Young will be notified of the restrictions upon radio contact with the lock.

3. Navigators should use extreme caution when entering or exiting the lock chamber.
