Overhead Transmission Line Replacement **Allegheny River, River Mile 23.8**

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that FirstEnergy of Greensburg, will be replacing a 138 kV transmission line crossing on the Allegheny River at river mile 23.8 downstream of Lock & Dam #4 in Brackenridge, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.
2. The power line replacement will consist of an aerial replacement with the use helicopters. There will be no work within the Allegheny River resulting in no delay or impact to navigation. Upon observation of an approaching vessel, the work will temporarily halt to let vessels pass through the work area. Work is expected to begin on May 7, 2012 and be completed by May 15, 2012. Work hours will be from 7am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday until completion.
3. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
4. Radio marine channels will not be monitored during the construction.
