Locks and Dam 4, Monongahela River, Mile 41.5 **Lock Closures for Blasting & Debris Removal Operations**

1. To All Whom It May Concern: Notice is given that Shaka/C.J. Mahan Construction Company, LLC, contractors for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, will be removing the old upstream guard wall at L/D 4, Monongahela River (Charleroi). Demolition blasting and debris removal operations will occur on January 15 and January 17, 2013 at 1:00 P.M. each day.

2. The following is the tentative blasting schedule .

Thursday January 17 @ 1:00 p.m. (loading explosives on Wed. 1/16)

Wednesday January 23 @ 10:00 a.m. (loading explosives on Mon. 1/21 & Tue. 1/22)

Friday January 25 @ 10:00 a.m. (loading explosives on Wed. after the 1/23 blast & Thur. 1/24)

Wednesday January 30 @ 10:00 a.m. (loading explosives on Mon. 1/28 & Tue. 1/29)

Friday February 1 @ 10:00 a.m. (loading explosives on Wed. after the 1/30 blast & Thur. 1/31)

The lock chamber will be closed on those dates and times and could last up to 8 hours.
