Allegheny L/D 9 Allegheny River Mile 62.2 Locks are Unavailable
For Service Due to Current Ice conditions on the Allegheny River**

UPDATE:

**Allegheny L/D 5 Allegheny River Mile 30.4 is Unavailable For
Service Due to Current Ice Conditions**

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that Allegheny L/D 5 Allegheny River mile 30.4, will be **unavailable for service** until further notice due to significant ice formations on the river.

2. A revised Navigation Notice will be posted once the ice has melted and the lock is back in service.

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the following locks on the Allegheny River are **unavailable for service** until further notice due to significant ice formations on the river:

Allegheny L/D 6, Allegheny River Mile 36.3
Allegheny L/D 7, Allegheny River Mile 45.7
Allegheny L/D 8, Allegheny River Mile 52.6
Allegheny L/D 9, Allegheny River Mile 62.2

2. These locks will remain **unavailable for service** until seasonal temperatures return to the region and the ice has melted. A revised Navigation Notice will be posted once these locks are passable. They will return to IMTS Level of Service 6, commercial lockage by appointment only.
