**Allegheny Lock and Dam 5, Allegheny River, Mile 30.4**  
**Temporary Revised Operating Schedule**

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S Army Corps of Engineers will **temporarily** reduce the hours of operation at Allegheny Lock and Dam 5, Allegheny River. Operating hours will change from the current service of 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM, 7 days per week, to 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM, 5 days per week (Thursday thru Monday).

2. This **temporary** reduction in service will be implemented on Saturday July 5, 2014. The first day of reduced service will begin on Tuesday July 8, 2014 and the second day Wednesday July 9, 2104. This schedule will be repeated weekly until further notice. During the reduced service period (Tuesdays and Wednesdays) commercial lockage will be made available by appointment.

3. Appointment lockages will be performed for Commercial Operators only between the hours of 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Commercial operators requiring appointment lockages at Lock 5 Allegheny River during the revised schedule must make arrangements at least 48 hours in advance. Reference Notice to Navigation Interest 14-20 for additional commercial lockage procedures.

4. As staffing shortages are resolved, Lock 5 Allegheny River will return to 7 days per week service. A revised Notice to Navigation Interest will be posted when this level of service will be provided.
