New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.3
Closure of the 110-ft x 1,200-ft Primary Lock Chamber

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will close the 110-ft x 1,200-ft primary lock chamber at New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.3.
2. This unscheduled outage will take place today 7 July, 2014 and is expected to last four (4) to eight (8) hours.
3. All Navigation traffic will lock through the 110-ft x 600-ft Auxiliary Lock Chamber.
4. **No multi-cut lockages will be permitted unless industry is willing to implement a voluntary self-help program.**
5. Navigators are requested to use caution when entering or leaving the auxiliary lock chamber to prevent a complete shutdown of navigation.
6. Minimal to moderate delays to Navigation traffic can be expected.
