Allegheny L/D 7 Mile Marker 45.7 Allegheny River
Unavailable For Service Due to Hydraulic Line Failure

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has closed the 56-ft x 360-ft lock chamber at Lock and Dam #7, Allegheny River, Mile 45.7. This lock will be closed until further notice due to a hydraulic line failure.
2. The system is currently being assessed and will be repaired as soon as practical.
3. The lock will remain **unavailable for service** until replacement a bad section of 3" supply piping can be replaced. A revised Navigation Notice will be posted once the repair is made and can be returned to IMTS Level of Service 6, commercial lockage by appointment only.
