Temporary Buoys, Monongahela River Mile 2.6-2.75

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that three temporary white buoys have been placed along the left descending bank of the Monongahela River at mile 2.6-2.75. The buoys are outside of, but near the navigation channel within this reach. They have been installed to mark the limits of the proposed Max Marina/Southside Marina as advertised in Public Notice 14-37. The buoys will be in place until approximately 26 September 2014. Notification will again be provided when they are removed.
2. Comments on the permit action for the marina are being accepted until 30 September 2014, as outlined in the Public Notice.
3. Minimal impacts to navigation traffic are expected by these markers.
