## Exploratory Drilling and Diving Operations along the Monongahela River, Left Descending Bank, Mile 125.5

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that Marion Hill Associates, INC. will be conducting exploratory boring and diving operations regarding the Big John Salvage Project for oil contaminates, on the left descending bank of the Monongahela River. The site location is approximate 10 miles above the Opekiska Lock and Dam, Monongahela River, at approximately River Mile 125.5, Fairmont, Marion County, West Virginia.
2. The work will be performed within a 10 hour time frame starting on May 6, 2014 at 07:00 a.m. to May 16, 2014, 5:00 p.m. During these periods the channel will **remain open**. Navigators are urged to use **caution** when transiting this area.
3. Equipment involved in the operation will be performed from the Motor Vessel (M/V) HARD HAT with an attached derrick barge.
4. The M/V HARD HAT will be monitoring marine band VHF Radio channel 13 and 16 transmissions to assist/coordinate with vessels transiting the work area.
