Braddock Locks and Dam, Monongahela River, Mile 11.3
110-ft X 720-ft Land Lock Chamber

1. To All Whom It May Concern: Notice is given that all up bound tows for the 110-ft X 720-ft land lock chamber at Braddock L/D will be required to lock off the Land Wall until further notice. When entering the land chamber, up bound tows are cautioned to stay flat on the land wall.
2. Locking up bound on the land wall has been necessitated due to the deterioration of the face and wall armor of the middle wall.
3. Navigators shall use caution when entering or leaving the land lock chamber in order to prevent damage to their vessels.
