DUTIES: Position will be filled at entry level. Upon completion of the formal training program full performance level duties include: Handle bow or stern lines, walk lines to proper locations along wall and snubs lines to assist maneuvering craft into position. Operate electrical or electronic gate control to open or close gates at end of lock chamber. Operate electrically, electronic, or hydraulically controlled valves controlling flow of water for emptying and filling operation, and during double lockage's, operates electrical tow haulage unit as applicable to move barges into/out of lock chamber. Eye and hand coordination and occasional lifting in excess of 50 pounds required. Work is outside subject to extreme temperature changes. Safety precautions are required.

QUALIFICATIONS: Resume should reflect experience in or related to knowledge of lock and dam equipment and machinery preventive maintenance, operation of lock and dam equipment and machinery, ability to follow instructions, ability to operate lock and dam equipment and machinery safely. U.S. Citizenship.
