New Cumberland L/D, Ohio River, Mile 54.4 Service Bridge Lift Span is Out-of-Operation

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given the New Cumberland Dam's service bridge lift span located upstream of the 110' x 600' land lock chamber is out of operational due to mechanical problems. The lift span is presently at elevation 722.0 providing a vertical clearance of 57.5 feet from normal upper pool for vessels using the land lock chamber. When operational, the lift span can be raised 10.5 feet to elevation 732.5 providing vessels a total vertical clearance of 68 feet from normal upper pool.
2. Both the 110' x 1200' river lock chamber and the 110' x 600' land lock chamber are available to navigation interests subject to the vertical clearance at elevation 722.0.
3. This notice will remain in effect until the operating machinery is repaired and the lift span can be fully raised.
