LOCK 2, MONONGAHELA RIVER

Damaged Mooring Cell at Monongahela River Mile 12.1

1. To All Whom It May Concern: Notice is given that the U.S. Government Mooring Cell, located along the right descending bank at Monongahela River mile 12.1 lost a considerable amount of cell fill material. The cell is structurally weakened and continued use of the cell by commercial vessels will cause loss of additional fill and could result in eventual collapse of the cell. Commercial vessels should avoid landing on or using this mooring cell.
2. There is another cell located along the right descending bank at Monongahela River mile 11.9 that is available for mooring commercial vessels.
3. The government is investigating the work required to repair the cell at river mile 12.1 and return it to service as quickly as possible.
