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**Allegheny Energy Supply Company, LLC, Hatfield's Ferry Power Station,  
Repairs to Limestone Unloader Sheet Pile Wall,  
Monongahela River, Mile 78.1, Left Bank**

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that River Salvage, contractor for the Allegheny Energy Supply Company, LLC, will be performing construction work along the left bank of the Monongahela River, in accordance with their permit 1968-002, at Mile 78.1, Masontown, Greene County, Pennsylvania.
2. The work will be performed from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Saturday, beginning September 28, 2012 and ending on or about October 31, 2012.
3. During this work, the M.V. Anna's Derrick Boat and an equipment barge will be used.
4. During non-working hours, the floating plant will be secured at the work site, on the left bank, and marked per inland navigation rules.
5. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
6. Mariners should monitor radio frequency channels 13 & 16 while transiting in the vicinity of the work site.
