## EnviroScience, Inc., Diving Operations Allegheny River, Miles 37.0 to 40.25

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN Notice is given that EnviroScience, Inc. is scheduled to conduct diving operations between Mile 37.0 to Mile 40.25 in Pool 6 on the left descending bank of the Allegheny River.
2. The diving operations will be conducted daily from 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., during the period from July 24 to August 10, 2007.
3. Dive vessel EO Wilson and support vessels will be monitoring VHF-FM Channel 13. Mariners are advised to contact the EO Wilson when transiting the area, since divers will need 15 minutes advance notice to clear out of the navigation channel. Delays to navigation are expected to be minimal.
