Temporary Barges  
Monongahela River, Right Bank, Mile 10.7

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that Universal Industrial Gases, Inc. will be temporarily installing two hopper barges along the right bank of the Monongahela River, approximate Mile 10.7, in Braddock, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.
2. The barges will be loaded with equipment from the dismantling of an air separation plant at the U. S. Steel Edgar Thompson works, and then transported down the Monongahela River. The barges will be moored directly along the wall, end to end, and as far downriver from Lock No. 2 as possible. The mooring will be upriver from the Braddock public launching ramp. The expected dates of the barge loadings will be from July 1, 2004 through July 31, 2004.
