## Maintenance Forebay Dredging Ohio River, Mile 111

1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that Rayle Coal Company, contractor for American Electric Power, Kammer Plant, will be performing maintenance forebay dredging at the Kammer Plant, along the left bank of the Ohio River, Mile 111.0, in Cresap, Marshall County, West Virginia.
2. The work will begin between July 22 and July 27, 2004 and will be completed between August 5 and August 10, 2004. Work will be conducted 8-12 hours/day, Monday through Friday and work could possibly be conducted on Saturdays and Sundays.
3. Equipment will be mounted on barges. Dredged material will be placed in barges and transported to Boggs Island on the Ohio River. During non-working hours, the barges will be moored near the work area at the Kammer plant. The contractor can be contacted by marine radio on Channels 12, 13 and 16.
4. Navigators, please use caution in and around the area.
