Warning to Recreational Boaters

1. Reference: Notice to Navigation #04-22.
2. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that conditions for boating on the Allegheny, Monongahela, and Ohio Rivers is very hazardous due to recent heavy rains which have caused local flooding in the area. In addition many of the "KEEP OUT - DAM" buoys placed upstream and downstream of navigation dams on the Allegheny, Monongahela, and Ohio Rivers have moved off station or been washed away during this flood event and may not be replaced during the remainder of the boating season. Recreational boaters are cautioned to always approach the locks and dams with **extreme** care, especially when proceeding downstream.
