Lock and Dam 5, Allegheny River, Mile 30.4
3-Day Closure of the Single, 56' x 360', Lock Chamber
to Install Upstream Lock Gates

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Repair Fleet will close the single, 56' x 360' lock chamber at Lock 5, Allegheny River, Mile 30.4 to install and align rehabilitated upstream lock gates. Work is scheduled to begin at 8:00 A.M. on December 7, 2004 and will be completed by 11:00 P.M. on December 9, 2004.
2. The single, 56' x 360', lock chamber will be closed to river traffic during the scheduled work period. No river traffic can pass through Lock 5 during this 3-day work period.
3. Normal wear and deterioration have made it necessary to schedule this work.
