Sunken Motor Vessel Chickasaw
Mile 0.0, Left Descending Bank, Ohio River

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the M/V Chickasaw is sunk at river mile 0.0 on the Ohio River. The vessel is located approximately 65 yards off of the left descending bank, riverward of the Consolidation Coal Company mooring facility. The 145 foot long vessel is currently resting in 20 feet of water with the top five feet of its super structure visible above the water line. The vessel is marked with white lights.
2. The United States Coast Guard Marine Safety Office has initiated removal of the vessel. The salvage operation is expected to begin in the near future and be completed by November 25, 2004.
3. Navigators are requested to use extreme caution when transiting this area.
