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**POINT MARION L/D, MONONGAHELA RIVER, MILE 90.8**  
**14-Day Closure of the Single 84' x 720' Lock Chamber**  
**Repair Lock Gates, Sills, and Miter Block Seals**

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Repair Fleet will close and dewater the single 84' x 720' lock chamber at Point Marion L/D, Monongahela River, Mile 90.8, to inspect and repair the lock gates, sills, and miter block seals. Work is scheduled to begin at 1:00 A.M. on March 29, 2005 and be completed by about 11:00 P.M. on April 11, 2005.
2. **The single 84' x 720' lock chamber will be closed during this 14-day closure period. No traffic will pass through the lock during this work period.**
3. General wear and deterioration of the lock gates, miter blocks, and other underwater operating components make it necessary to schedule this work.
