Montgomery Locks and Dam, Ohio River, Mile 31.7
Repair Operating Machinery on the Land Wall Emptying Valve

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Repair Fleet will make repairs to the operating machinery of the land wall 13' x 14' emptying valve at Montgomery Locks and Dam, Ohio River, Mile 31.7. Work is scheduled to begin at about 11:00 P.M. on March 23, 2006 and be completed by about 11:00 P.M. on March 30, 2006.
2. The 56-ft x 360-ft lock chamber will be closed to river traffic during this 7-day work period. The large 110-ft x 600-ft lock chamber will be open to navigation during this work period except as follows. Large chamber closures of up to 4-hours will occur periodically (approximately 3 times during the 7-day work period) to move and install valve parts and equipment on the land wall. Intermittent delays are expected.
3. Wear and deterioration of the valve operating machinery have made it necessary to schedule this work.
4. Navigators please note the location and duration of this work and use caution when entering and leaving the lock chamber.
