Temporary Lowering of Pools for Dive Inspections and Sounding Surveys
Lock and Dam 5, Allegheny River, Mile 30.4 and
Lock and Dam 6, Allegheny River Mile 36.3

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will be conducting dive inspections and sounding surveys, river conditions permitting, at Lock and Dam 5, Allegheny River Miles 30.4 and Lock and Dam 6, Allegheny River Mile 36.3. The work is scheduled to be performed within the times noted below.
 - Dive inspections will be conducted the week of 6 thru 10 October 2008, with the exact hours expected to fluctuate.
 - Sounding surveys will be conducted the week of 13 thru 17 October 2008, with the exact hours expected to fluctuate.
2. In association with this work, the upper pool will be temporarily drawn down for a maximum of 72 hours by the hydropower project at Lock and Dam 5 to elevation 756.0' and at Lock and Dam 6 to elevation 768.4' to provide suitable conditions for these efforts. This elevation equates to an upper pool gage reading of 8.0 or a water level 1.0 feet below the crest of the dam at both projects. This will result in a total change of approximately 8 to 12 inches below the normal pool levels.
3. Navigators are cautioned to travel within the limits of the navigation channel during this temporary lowering of the upper pool. In addition, marina owners and owners of private docking facilities upstream of these dams may be temporarily affected by this work and the associated pool draw downs.
