MAHONING CREEK LAKE CELEBRATES ENGINEERS' WEEK

MAHONING CREEK LAKE -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Pittsburgh District, invites members of the public to an open house at [Mahoning Creek Lake](#), located near Dayton, Pa., to celebrate National Engineers Week (February 22-28). During this week, Mahoning Creek Lake will open its doors for two days – February 24 and 26 – from noon until 2 p.m. The open house, located at the resource manager's office, is free. All visitors 16 years of age and over will be required to show valid photo identification.

The event will feature an exhibit and general information on the history of Mahoning Dam, the fifth tallest dam in the Pittsburgh District. The staff at the facility will also be available to answer questions on the various missions of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Pittsburgh District and Mahoning Creek Lake.

Mahoning Creek Lake is also offering dam tours on February 25 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. and on February 28, at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. (The tours are subject to cancellation). Each tour is limited to 10 adults and all dam tour participants must register in advance. To register for a dam tour on February 25 please call before February 9 and for a tour on February 28 call before February 13.

National Engineers Week was created in 1951 to increase public awareness and appreciation of the engineering profession. It encompasses the week of George Washington's birthday since our first president was a military engineer and land surveyor. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is the world's largest public engineering organization.
