MAHONING CREEK LAKE – Tired of the Day-After Thanksgiving shopping tradition? Why not start a new tradition and take a tour of the Mahoning Dam? The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Mahoning Creek Lake staff will offer special Day-After Thanksgiving Dam Tours on Friday, November 26, at 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Participants will be able to go inside the dam, see how it's operated and maintained, and learn about how it was built. Additional highlights of the tour include magnificent Fall views from the top of the dam and being below the elevation of the discharge gates.

For security and scheduling purposes, Day-After Thanksgiving Dam Tour participants must register before November 12. Each tour is limited to 10 adults and valid government issued photo identification is required.
