Tour the Tower at Tionesta

TIONESTA LAKE – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will host tours of the Tionesta Dam Control Tower on Tuesday, July 4; Sunday, August 27 and Monday, September 4 from 1:00 p.m. until 2:45 p.m. Each tour will be approximately 15 minutes in length and will provide visitors the opportunity to see the inter-workings of a flood control dam. Pre-registration for the free tours is encouraged but not required. Valid government issued photo identification (e.g., driver's license) is required for all tower tour participants 16 years of age and older. Backpacks, bags and cameras will not be permitted in the control tower. Tionesta Lake, located just 1 mile south of Tionesta, Pa. on State Route 36, is one of 16 flood control projects in the Pittsburgh District and has prevented nearly \$522 million in flood damages since its completion in 1940.
