

**PROJECT FACT SHEET
CONSTRUCTION GENERAL**

PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Granville, PA Local Flood Protection Project

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The Granville Local Flood Protection Project is located on Gorby and Pike Runs in the Village of Granville, Washington County, Pennsylvania. The original project consists of 4,600 feet of channel improvement; stone bank protection in certain locations; removal of approximately 34,500 cubic yards of mine spoilage; and 210 feet of rock faced earthen dike. Repairs are to involve removing deposited sediments from the left side of the channel to re-establish the original 20 foot wide channel bottom. The right (failed) bank/berm would be stepped and scarified in preparation for placing fill material to its original (2H:1V) slope. To the greatest extent possible the excavated sediments would be used to supplement the required fill. A keyway would be excavated at the toe of the slope to stabilize the protection. The bank would be lined with a filter fabric liner, a six inch layer of bedding stone, and a 36 inch layer of adequately sized rip-rap. A keyway will also be placed on the slope at the upstream and downstream end of the project to prevent outflanking of the protection. This protection will be placed to the full height (10 feet) of the bank for approximately 180 linear feet and transition down to the toe as required. A stone groin is to be added to reduce future sedimentation along the left bank across from the repaired berm.
