PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Section 1135, Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) - Project Modifications for Improvement of the Environment

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: This program services the portions of five states that fall within the boundaries of the Pittsburgh District. This program involves the study, design and construction of modifications or restoration measures to Corps of Engineers' constructed projects that will improve the quality of the Environment.

TOTAL PROJECT COST: Varies by Project
Total Federal Cost: \$5,000,000 Maximum per Project
Total Non-Federal Cost: 25% of Total Project Cost

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: This program requires a non-federal sponsor to cost-share in the project modifications or restoration measures at 25% of the total project cost.

CURRENT STATUS: There are currently three active projects in various stages of planning and design. However, as of March 04, all Sec 1135 funds have been pulled from Districts and sent to the Chicago District.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 1135, Water Resources Development Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-662), as amended.
