

**PROJECT FACT SHEET  
CONSTRUCTION GENERAL**

**PROJECT NAME AND STATE:** Section 14, Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) -  
Emergency Streambank Protection Projects

**LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:** This program services the portions of five states that fall within the boundaries of the Pittsburgh District. This Program involves design and construction of emergency projects to protect public or non-profit public facilities and/or services that are threatened by natural processes on streambanks and shorelines and are essential and important enough to merit federal participation in their protection.

**TOTAL PROJECT COST:** Varies by Project  
**Total Federal Cost:** \$1,000,000 Maximum per Project  
**Total Non-Federal Cost:** 35% of Total Project Cost

**NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR:** This program requires a sponsor to cost-share at a rate of 35% of the total project costs. A minimum of 5% of the non-federal sponsor contribution shall be in cash.

**CURRENT STATUS:** There are currently 14 active projects in various stages of planning, design and construction.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Section 14, Flood Control Act of 1946 (Public Law 79-526), as amended.
