

**PROJECT FACT SHEET
CONSTRUCTION GENERAL**

PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Weston, WV - Emergency Streambank Protection (Section 14)

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The project is located on the right bank (when looking downstream) of the West Fork River adjacent to US Route 19 in Weston, WV. There is approximately 300 feet of the Route 19 highway embankment that is in danger of failure due to erosion of the riverbank due to stream flows. The purpose of the Section 14 project is to stabilize the embankment adjacent to US Route 19 to prevent failure.

TOTAL PROJECT COST: To be Determined
Total Federal Cost: \$1,000,000 Maximum per Project
Total Non-Federal Cost: 35% of Total Project Costs

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: City of Weston, WV

CURRENT STATUS: The topographic survey work was completed on July 7, 2003. The project is currently under Design in the Plans and Specs stage (PDA Phase). Copies of the drawings, draft PCA and Fact Sheet were sent to the City of Weston on 24 June 04 and they were asked to respond with comments by 15 Sept 04. Since we are in the preliminary stages of Design, the time period for award of a construction contract is currently estimated to be in FY 05.
