

**PROJECT FACT SHEET
CONSTRUCTION GENERAL**

PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Section 205, Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) - Small Local Flood Damage Reduction Projects

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: This program services the portions of five states that fall within the boundaries of the Pittsburgh District. This program involves the study, design and construction of projects that protect communities from flooding.

TOTAL PROJECT COST: Varies by Project
Total Federal Cost: \$7,000,000 Maximum per Project
Total Non-Federal Cost: 50% of Study Costs over \$100,000;
35% of Design and Construction Costs

NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR: This program requires a sponsor to cost-share at a rate of 50% of Feasibility Study costs over \$100, 000 and 35% of Design and Construction costs.

CURRENT STATUS: There are currently three active projects in various stages of planning and design.

AUTHORIZATION: Section 205, Flood Control Act of 1948 (Public Law 80-858), as amended.
