

**PROJECT FACT SHEET  
CONSTRUCTION GENERAL**

**PROJECT NAME AND STATE:** Saxman Run, PA

**LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:** The project is located in Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania near the City of Latrobe and the town of West Derry. The project will consist of restoration of approximately 3 miles of Saxman Run. The stream is extremely affected by acid mine drainage and is almost devoid of any aquatic life. Secondary benefits will be seen in the Loyalhanna Creek and the Corps' Loyalhanna Lake.

<b>Total Federal Cost:</b>	\$3,863,000
<b>Total Non-Federal Cost:</b>	\$2,080,000

**NON-FEDERAL SPONSOR:** The official sponsor is the Loyalhanna Watershed Association. However, there are many other partners involved through the Loyalhanna Creek Mine Drainage Coalition.

**CURRENT STATUS:** Currently the project is in the Detailed Project Report (DPR), or feasibility, phase. This phase will investigate multiple potential treatment sites and determine how best to treat the mine drainage. The DPR was scheduled for completion in 2004, however, recent budget cuts have delayed completion until FY 2005, at the earliest.

**AUTHORIZATION:** Section 206, Water Resources Development Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-303), as amended.
