PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Streets Run Watershed, 905(b) Reconnaissance Study

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Streets Run, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. The reconnaissance study evaluated potential methods to reduce flooding along Streets Run, such as the construction of storm water detention basins placed in strategic locations within the watershed.

CURRENT STATUS: The reconnaissance study was completed in the Fall of 2003. The findings were negative. No economically justifiable method was found to reduce the flooding along Streets Run.
