

**PROJECT FACT SHEET  
GENERAL INVESTIGATIONS**

**PROJECT NAME AND STATE:** Steubenville Port Project, Steubenville, OH

**LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:** The Reconnaissance Study identified five sites adjacent to the Ohio River along a 48 mile reach, called the "Steubenville Area", that were considered capable of supporting development of ports for public use. These sites were located at (1) river mile (r.m.) 87 just south of Yorkville, (2) between r.m. 84 and 86 near Rayland, (3) between r.m. 80 and 82 just north of Rayland, (4) between r.m. 56 and 59 near Toronto, and (5) between r.m. 48 and 50 near Wellsville. This area includes portions of Jefferson and Columbiana Counties in Western Ohio. The Feasibility Study will likely focus on one of these sites for more detailed study.
