PROJECT NAME AND STATE: Kinzua Dam and Allegheny Reservoir, PA & NY - Construct Handicapped-Accessible Fishing Pier and Upgrade Visitor Center Displays

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Kinzua Dam is located on the Allegheny River, 9 miles above Warren, Pennsylvania. The proposed improvements include construction of a handicapped accessible fishing pier, parking area and paved walkway to the pier. In addition, new displays will be built and installed at the existing Visitor Center.

CURRENT STATUS: Design of pier and related items is complete. Bids came in much higher than expected. Cost-lowering design changes are being investigated. Prospectus for Visitor Center upgrade has been completed and other documents necessary for Request for Proposals to be issued are being prepared.

AUTHORIZATION: Flood Control Acts of 1936 and 1938 for flood control, low water regulation and recreation; Flood Control Act of 1944 for construction, operations and maintenance of recreation facilities.
