

# Rules and Regulations

***In addition to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Rules and Regulations (36 Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter III, Part 327) the following rules and regulations apply at East Branch Clarion River Lake.***



## East Branch Campground

- ❖ Campers must self-register at the Fee Booth. Individuals registering must be at least 18 years old and have a valid driver's license or other government issued photo ID and must occupy the site.
- ❖ Campsites are on a first-come, first-served basis. No one may register for more than one site or save/hold a site for someone else. Placing camping equipment at a campsite for the purpose of reserving the site for future occupancy is prohibited.
- ❖ Campers must have camping equipment with them and set-up their campsite immediately after registering. Registering for a campsite and returning at a later time to set-up is not permitted.
- ❖ No more than two tents used for occupancy are permitted per campsite. A maximum of eight people are permitted on a campsite.
- ❖ Camping is permitted in designated areas only. Camping in areas other than the campground is prohibited.
- ❖ Registered campers are responsible for all activities at their campsite and the conduct of their visitors. Visitors must depart by 10:00 p.m.
- ❖ Campsites must be vacated or renewed prior to 3:00 p.m. on the day the permit expires.
- ❖ Length of stay is limited to 14 consecutive days or 14 days in a 30-day period. Campers wishing to stay more than 14 days must obtain the approval of Park Management and move from the current campsite. No extensions on holiday weekends.
- ❖ Quiet shall be maintained between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Generators may not be operated during these hours.
- ❖ Campsite, including fire rings, shall be kept free of litter, refuse and animal waste. Fire rings may not be moved or used for disposal of litter and refuse. Campsites shall be clean upon departure.
- ❖ Care shall be exercised in building and extinguishing campfires. Fires may only be built in fire rings.
- ❖ Registered campers who own a vessel may obtain a Camper Pass to use the boat launch ramps free of charge. The Camper Pass can be obtained at the Park Office or from a Park Ranger.
- ❖ No parking is permitted along roadways, in between campsites, in front of gates or on adjacent/unoccupied campsites.
- ❖ Vehicles, boats or other equipment that cannot be parked on the camper's registered campsite are to be parked in the Overlook Picnic Area parking lots.
- ❖ Golden Age/Access Passports and America the Beautiful Senior/Access Passes are honored for half price camping fees. The pass holder must present the pass in person when registering and renewing, and must be an occupant of the site.

- ❖ The use or possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on all East Branch Clarion River Lake lands and water.
- ❖ Firearms, fireworks and explosives of any kind are prohibited in the campground.
- ❖ Pets are permitted, provided they are caged, penned, on a leash not longer than six feet or otherwise physically restrained at all times. Leashes may only be attached to the camper's own equipment, not trees or other vegetation, site posts, tables or fire rings. Nuisance, vicious, wild or exotic pets or animals are prohibited. Owners are required to clean-up after their pets and may not leave them unattended.
- ❖ Bicycles are permitted in all recreation areas. Operators must ride on the road with traffic and obey all signs, including one way, yield and stop. Bicycles are not permitted off the road, in the grass, on trails, bridges or sidewalks.
- ❖ Parents are responsible for children using any playground equipment.
- ❖ All motorized recreational vehicles, including motorcycles, motorbikes, mopeds, scooters, golf carts and ATVs, that are not legally road licensed are prohibited in the campground.
- ❖ The destruction, injury, defacement or removal of public property including vegetation, trees, rocks or minerals, is prohibited. The hanging of lanterns, tools or trash bags from trees is prohibited. No foreign objects such as nails or spikes may be driven into trees.
- ❖ Cutting standing trees is prohibited. Firewood may be gathered only from trees that are dead and fallen. Do not remove logs that delineate trails.
- ❖ Individuals who are boisterous, rowdy, disorderly, or otherwise disturb the peace may be issued a citation and requested to leave the project. Violators of these rules and regulations may be issued citations and evicted.




