- **B.** Typical year assessment(s): Though the site delineation visit was done during drought times, a FEMA map (effective 7/7/2009) was provided to demonstrate that the site is in an area of minimal flood hazard (Zone X).
- **C.** Additional comments to support AJD: The submission describes that the delineated area was historically a coal-mine area that was not restored to pre-construction contours. It was noted that the

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site may have been a spoil pile. It is reasonable that a spoil pile that was never graded and compacted would have developed erosional gullies similar to the features that were present onsite.

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
