

## Basic Rules & Safety Reminders for Loyalhanna

- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at all times. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- Sites are limited to one camping unit per site. A second tent may be used only for children 18 years of age or younger.
- No more than two vehicles per site, additional vehicles can park in the day use lot.
- Parking on campsite grass is prohibited.
- Help yourself to all DEAD wood in the campground vicinity
- Quiet hours after 10:00 p.m. All visitors must leave the campground by this time.
- All visitors must see a Park Ranger for a visitor parking permit.
- Swimming is permitted; swim at your own risk.
- Fishing, swimming and loitering at the boat launch and dock area is prohibited at all times. Dock and ramp are for loading and unloading only.
- Use provided dumpsters and garbage cans to dispose of your trash.
- Make sure to be equipped with properly sized PFDs for boating and canoe safety. Loyalhanna boaters ARE REQUIRED to follow all Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission rules and regulations.
- Keep radio/sound devices at a level that is considerate of others.
- Campground sites are first-come, first-served basis. Putting a tag on a site post without visual occupancy is prohibited.  
Leaving boats at the dock for an extended amount of time is prohibited. Boaters are permitted to pull boats onto the sand strip shoreline. However, boaters are responsible for watching their boats.
- The speed limit in the park is 10 mph. Exceeding the 10 mph speed limit is prohibited at all times.  
Follow signs for day use and boat trailer parking options.
