**Pittsburgh District Repair Fleet**  
**Working at Willow Island L/D**  
**Ohio River, Mile 161.7**

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the Pittsburgh District Repair Fleet will be working outside of our district boundaries at Willow Island Locks and Dam on the Ohio River from August 5, 2013 to September 13, 2013. The Pittsburgh District maintenance staff and Repair Fleet, which typically performs major maintenance repairs at Pittsburgh District navigation and flood risk management structures, will be completing maintenance work for the Huntington District during this period.
2. The Pittsburgh District Repair Fleet will temporarily be stationed at River Mile 161.7 on the Ohio River, which is outside the boundary limits of the Pittsburgh District.
3. The general public is being notified because in the event of an emergency at one of the Pittsburgh District facilities, the Repair Fleet will need additional time to respond. Businesses and municipalities located on the rivers and the navigation industry are being notified for situational awareness.
