Closure of the 110' x 600' Land Lock Chamber

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will close the small 110'x 600' land lock chamber for four (4) hours on June 4, 2013. During the closure the US Coast Guard Marine Safety Unit Pittsburgh will conduct its annual Area Maritime Security Training and Exercise Program (AMSTEP) which will test the ability to effectively implement security procedures, physical security measures, Operations Security (OPSEC) measures, and Command, Control, and Communications (C3) as a result of MARSEC level changes or receipt of threat information.

2. The small 110' x 600' land chamber will be closed to navigation traffic from 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M the following dates:

- Monday June 24, 2013

3. All traffic will pass through the large 110' x 1,200' river lock chamber during these closures. Minimal to no delays to navigation are expected.

4. Navigators are requested to use caution when entering or leaving the river lock chamber during the closure of the land chamber to prevent a complete shutdown of navigation.
