**Lock 2, Allegheny River, Mile 6.7**  
**Intermittent Closures of the Single, 56' x 360' Lock Chamber**

1. **TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Repair Fleet will be working in the single 56' x 360' lock chamber at Lock 2, Allegheny River. There will be intermittent closures of the lock chamber to repair the crossover hydraulic piping. The repair work is scheduled to begin at 12:01 AM on May 7, 2012 and will be completed by 11:00 PM on May 25, 2012.
2. The single 56' x 360' lock chamber will experience intermittent closures of up to 4 hours on Mondays through Fridays during the work period. Interested parties should contact Lock 2, Allegheny by Marine Radio or phone 412-661-2217 to get the operational status of the lock chamber for the day.
3. Normal wear and deterioration have made it necessary to schedule this work.
