Installation of Pipeline Crossing Monongahela River, River Mile 118.0

1. **TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** Notice is given that Sheehan Pipeline Construction Company/Southeast Directional Drilling, LLC, a contractor for M3 Appalachia Gathering, LLC., will install a gas pipeline crossing on the Monongahela River at river mile 118.0 near Jordan, Marion County, West Virginia.
2. The construction will consist of the use of a horizontal directional drilling (HDD) rig to drill and install a 16-inch gas pipeline underneath the Monongahela River. The HDD equipment will be working approximately 700 feet outside of the river banks and no work within the river is proposed. Work hours during drilling of the pilot hole will be from 7:00 am – 7:00 pm, 6 days/week and 24 hours/day, 7 days/week during completion. Work commenced on May 1, 2012 and is expected to be completed no later than August 1, 2012.
3. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
4. Radio marine channels will not be monitored during the construction.
