Dashields Locks and Dam, Ohio River, Mile 13.3 Closure of the 110-ft x 600-ft Primary Lock Chamber

UPDATE:

- 1. TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Notice is given that the U.S Army Corps of Engineers Repair Fleet will be working on installing a new maintenance closure system for the 110-ft x 600-ft Primary Lock Chamber. This work will be performed in two phases. The first phase of the repair work is scheduled to begin at 12:01 AM on May 12, 2014 and will be completed by 11:00 PM on June 6, 2014.
- 2. The 110-ft x 600-ft Primary Lock Chamber at Dashields will be **closed** to all navigation during this work period. All navigation traffic will pass through the 56-ft x 360-ft Auxiliary Lock Chamber. Major delays to navigation are expected.
- 3. Schedule permitting, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Repair Fleet will open the 110-ft x 600-ft primary lock chamber for Memorial Day weekend. The primary lock chamber will be open to navigation from 11:00 PM May 23, 2014 through 11:00 PM May 26, 2014. After that time the 110-ft x 600-ft primary lock chamber will remain closed to navigation until 11:00 PM on June 6, 2014.
