Test Boring - Kiskimintas River Miles 2-3

1. **To All Whom It May Concern:** Notice is given that Pennsylvania Drilling Company, contractor for the Municipal Authority of Allegheny Township will be conducting test boring for the new pump station and force main design in three (3) locations in Kiskimintas River, between approximate Miles 2 and 3, located in Allegheny Township, Westmoreland County and Gilpin Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania.
2. The work will consist of a small tracked drill rig on a floating barge that will drill three vertical borings at the three separate locations. Soil augering and rock coring will be performed. No cables extending to the shoreline or anchors blocking navigation of the river will be used.
3. The work will begin on May 19, 2014 and be completed May 30, 2014. Work hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
4. Radio marine channels will not be monitored during the replacement project.
5. Navigators, please note the location and duration of this work and use caution in and around the area.
